RO WATER STORAGE TANKS PROJECT

The City of Seymour is scheduled to begin the water storage tank rehabilitation project on Monday October 30th, 2023. This project is essential to maintaining our water storage capacity and will help to provide high quality water for the citizens of Seymour and the customers of Baylor County SUD. The first phase begins with the draining of one of our large water tanks which will then be taken out of service. Once out of service the tank will be cleaned, sandblasted, and the inside will be resurfaced. Once the tank is taken out of service the water storage capacity will drop to approximately 70 percent. At that time the City will need to initiate **STAGE 1** of our drought contingency plan. Stage 1 is initiated when the water storage capacity drops below 80%.

The response of the community for Stage 1 is imperative to maintaining an adequate water supply. We are requesting customers:

1. Voluntarily limit irrigation of yards/gardens to two days a week.
2. Check for leaks, dripping faucets, and running toilets.

We will remain in Stage 1 until approximately 30 days after the Water Tank project is completed or conditions favor a more stringent water conversation plan.

WE MUST ALL DO OUR PART TO ENSURE THE PROJECT RUNS SMOOTHLY AND EVERYONE HAS WATER THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE TANK REHABILITATION ENDEAVOR.
